ORDER

On October 19, 2023, Plaintiff Steven E. Greer (“Greer”) gave notice of voluntary dismissal of all Defendants in the case. On October 20, 2023, this Court entered an order dismissing the case with prejudice. On October 27, 2023, Greer appealed that order to the Fifth Circuit. On November 14, 2023, before the appeal was transmitted, this Court set aside the original order and entered an amended order dismissing the case without prejudice pursuant to Federal Rules of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A(i) and 41(a)(1)(B).¹

On March 11, 2024, the Fifth Circuit ordered the case remanded for the limited purpose of “explain[ing] whether Greer has previously dismissed any action

based on the same claim or, in the alternative, to DISMISS WITHOUT PREJUDICE Greer's action."² As explained above, this case has been dismissed without prejudice since November 14, 2023. Accordingly, the Court hereby

ORDERS that the case remains **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.
